Tasks and Responsibilities:

The Day Camp Counsellors will support the Bragg Creek Community Association's summer camps for children ages 5–12. This role is all about helping kids have an amazing, active, and safe summer in our very outdoorsy Bragg Creek environment.

- Coaches will work closely with the Camp Leader – Head Coach and the Peak Ambition Sport Camp team to deliver daily camp activities.
- Counsellors are the hands-on leaders who bring each activity to life. They will help set up and run games, sports, outdoor adventures, crafts, nature-based experiences, and special workshops with local partners.
- Daily responsibilities include supervising campers, guiding small groups through activities, supporting behaviour management with patience and kindness, encouraging teamwork, and helping kids try new skills.
- Counsellors will be responsible for maintaining safety in all settings — especially during outdoor programming — and will follow all safety protocols and emergency procedures taught during training.
- Counsellors will also help with basic camp operations such as set-up and clean-up of activity areas, preparing materials, supporting attendance tracking, and helping the Camp Leader with smooth transitions throughout the day.

This role offers great opportunities for youth to build leadership, communication, and problem-solving skills. Counsellors will receive coaching and mentorship from the Camp Leader and from Peak Ambition staff, giving them daily support and feedback so they can grow in confidence as young leaders in the community.

Interested candidates should meet the following criteria:

Interested candidates ages 15-30 are encouraged to apply. (This is a Canada Summer Jobs Funded Position, so applicants **must** be within the age requirements, and be a Canadian Citizen, Permanent Resident, or Person with Refugee Protection)

Youth facing barriers to employment are encouraged to apply. Accommodation measures are available (for example, physical, visual, or auditory accessibility accommodations, flexible work arrangements, or space for cultural, spiritual, or religious practices)
