#### **Tasks and Responsibilities:**

- Plan and coordinate weekly camp activities under Peak Ambition leadership, making sure each week includes a balanced mix of athletic fundamentals, outdoor adventure, creative projects, team-building games, and nature-based learning.
- Create detailed daily schedules and prep activity materials in advance so camp counsellors feel prepared, supported, and confident running programs.
- Leading camp activities and engage with campers, acting as a role model for the Camp Counsellors
- Provide on-site leadership for the camp team, including giving direction to counsellors, delegating tasks, supporting group management, and helping create a positive, safe, and inclusive environment for all campers.
- Mentor and coach camp counsellors, modelling strong leadership, communication, and problem-solving skills. Offer daily check-ins and helpful feedback to build their confidence and abilities.
- Ensure safety protocols are followed, including risk assessments for outdoor activities, first aid procedures, sign-in/out systems, and emergency response plans.
- Communicate with parents and guardians when needed, providing updates, answering questions, and handling minor concerns with professionalism.

- Work collaboratively with facilitators and community partners on unique weekly experiences (facilitators will lead specialty outdoor and stewardship activities, such as guided nature walks, foraging sessions, fly-fishing basics, outdoor skills).
- Foster a positive camp culture where kids feel supported, welcomed, and excited to try new things.
- Help manage behaviour challenges with patience, empathy, and clear problem-solving strategies, promoting respect, teamwork, and kindness.
- Promote environmental responsibility by modelling Leave No Trace principles, encouraging campers to care for trails and play areas, and weaving stewardship themes into daily activities.
- Assist with set-up and take-down of camp spaces, equipment, and materials, ensuring everything is clean, safe, and ready for the next day.

This role offers great opportunities to build leadership, communication, and problem-solving skills. The Camp Leader will receive training and mentorship from Peak Ambition staff, giving them daily support and feedback so they can grow in confidence as a community leader.

**Interested candidates should meet the following criteria:**

Interested candidates ages 15-30 are encouraged to apply. (This is a Canada Summer Jobs Funded Position, so applicants **must** be within the age requirements, and be a Canadian Citizen, Permanent Resident, or Person with Refugee Protection)

Youth facing barriers to employment are encouraged to apply. Accommodation measures are available (for example, physical, visual, or auditory accessibility accommodations, flexible work arrangements, or space for cultural, spiritual, or religious practices)
